

Call for Member Interest Ethernet-APL Seminar Series

The four organizations that supported the development of Ethernet-APL (FieldComm Group, ODVA, OPC Foundation, and PROFIBUS and PROFINET International) are exploring the possibility of a joint in-person seminar series ("roadshow"). The goal of this collaboration is to communicate to the broader market – and end users specifically – that Ethernet-APL is an open technology that is being backed by major standards development organizations and industrial automation companies in a truly cooperative manner.

We are seeking expressions of interest to participate so that we can determine if this seminar series is viable.

- Prospective locations: Southern California, New Jersey, Houston
- Prospective dates: Within a 7-10 day period in October 2025
- Prospective member sponsorship levels. This seminar series must be funded completely
